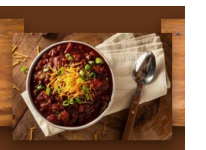
THANKSGIVING DINNER

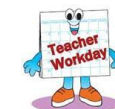

Sister to Sister Afternoon Retreat

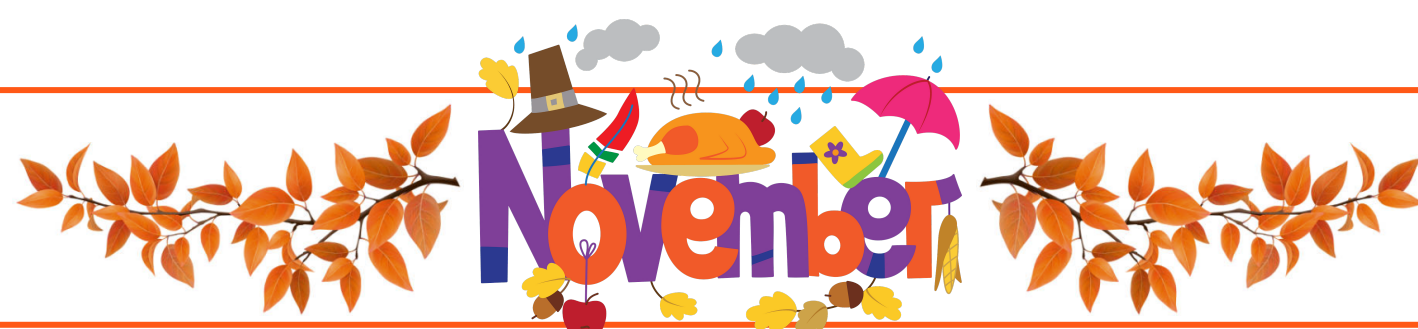

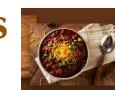

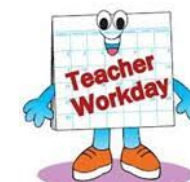
