

RETURNING TO WORSHIP
“THINGS TO CONSIDER”

1. We will offer two identical services on Sundays at 9:00 am (for members whose last name begins with A-H) and 11:00 am (for members whose last names begin with I-Z). Note that we have divided the congregation alphabetically to allow us to maintain an appropriate number of people at each worship service. **The worship service you should attend could change as more members return to worship at the building.** If there is a change we will post that on the message board. Each service will be approximately 45 minutes. Please plan to arrive no earlier than 15 minutes prior to the start of our worship services. **The 11:00 am service will be livestreamed.**
2. Do not attend if you are feeling sick or running a fever or if you have been exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the past two weeks.
3. Do not attend if you are in a high-risk category or feel uncomfortable being in public.
4. Please wear a mask until you are seated in the auditorium. Once you are seated, the mask is optional.
5. You will be greeted and welcomed as usual (but following social distancing guidelines).
6. To help with social distancing, please avoid congregating in the lobbies and hallways. Please go directly to the auditorium.
7. You will find communion supplies already in the pew in front of you. The Lord’s Supper will be observed at the end of the worship service.
8. There will be receptacles for your contribution. On your way into the auditorium or on your way out, you can drop your contribution in the labeled receptacles.
9. Water fountains will not be useable. Restrooms will be available, but please make sure there is room for social distancing if you need to enter a restroom.
10. For now, we will not have Sunday morning Bible class, Sunday evening worship and mid-week Bible study at the building. This will still be available online.
11. Please do not sit in rows that are marked off. You will probably not be sitting in your usual pew.
12. We will be skipping rows and families sitting on the same row please leave appropriate space between you and the next family.
13. Pew Bibles, song books, attendance cards and pencils have been removed.
14. Currently, childcare will not be provided.
15. We have tried to make this a touchless event. Keep in mind that we are still being advised not to shake hands or hug each other.
16. All doors will be propped open.
17. We will not hand out bulletins or have them available.
18. Once worship service has concluded, please exit the building and feel free to fellowship and visit outside.
